Speaking and listening	- Understands instructions with context clues (visuals, support from peers) - Can answer yes/no questions, or single word answers	- Understands standard speech to follow the outline of discussions - Communicates increasingly in longer phrases/short sentences	- Understands more idiomatic or abstract ideas - Can express more detailed opinions and beliefs, and defend them	- Understands conversations on familiar topics, even when context or speaker is unfamiliar - Vocabulary growing to include technical terms, imagery, and colloquialisms	- Can follow and evaluate more complex arguments - Expresses themselves fluently, with increasing ability to plan speech for structure and impact
Reading and writing	- Can answer simple true/false questions - Can write single word answers to questions	- Understands simple subject terminology (e.g. equals or chapter) - Writes in simple, coherent sentences about themselves and everyday activities	- Understands implied or figurative meaning - Communicates effectively with basic descriptions of images/events	- Can use strategies to decode unfamiliar words/meanings - Can develop more complex ideas in their writing, related to audience/purpose	- Understands the impact of writer's methods on readers - Plans writing for impact, using methods (e.g. metaphor) and editing
